



Update 22nd February 2021

Following on from the Government announcement today, we wanted to update you on the roadmap for weddings.

According to the information released so far:

- 8th March (phase 1) – wedding ceremonies with up to six people will be permitted
- 12th April (phase 2) – wedding and wedding receptions restricted to 15 people with social distancing will be permitted
- 17th May (phase 3) – wedding and wedding receptions restricted to 30 people with social distancing will be permitted
- 21st June (phase 4) – weddings and wedding receptions resume with no legal limits

We realise this affects a number of forthcoming weddings and we will be contacting couples as soon as possible to discuss a way forward. Please bear with us as we work through the dates, restrictions and availability. We may have some availability this year or early next year if couples do not want to go ahead with the number restrictions.

Ultimately there is light at the end of the tunnel and we look forward greatly to resuming weddings properly.
